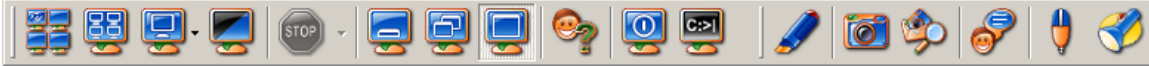


# Customizing the Vision Toolbar

## What is the Vision Toolbar?

The Vision Toolbar is a floating toolbar designed specifically for the teacher's desktop from which several management and teaching functions can be accessed. Because it is integrated into Windows Explorer, it is always available no matter what applications are being used. By default, it is positioned at the top of your desktop and looks like this:



## How is the Vision Toolbar customizable?

The Vision Toolbar allows teachers to put their favorite teaching tools from several MasterSolution products at their fingertips - it's not product specific. Any feature from compatible MasterSolution products can be customized for the Vision Toolbar. This means that the Vision Toolbar can be set to contain only the items you need the most.

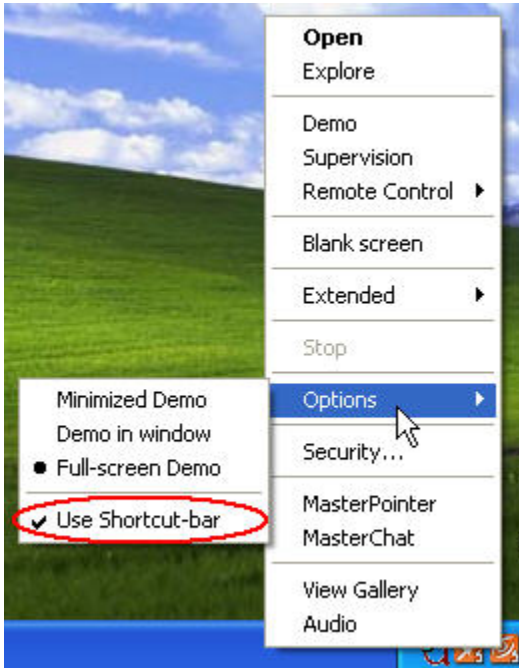
## I have Vision and MasterPointer Toolbars already, so how does customizing the Vision Toolbar help me?

Vision ships with the MasterPointer annotation tool included. Normally, MasterPointer uses its own toolbar, but by customizing the Vision Toolbar you can incorporate your favorite features from both products into one convenient palette.

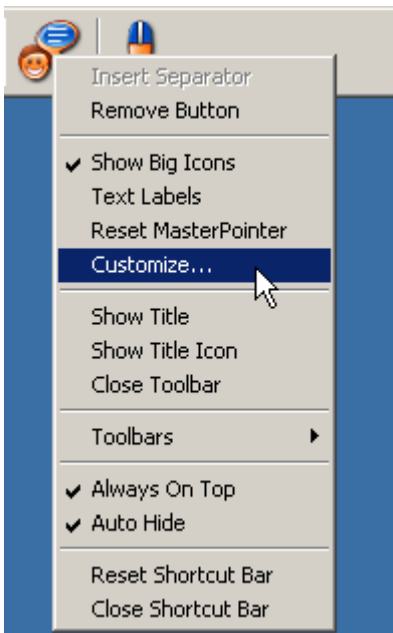
The following steps allow you to customize your own Vision Toolbar in minutes.

# How to customize your Vision Toolbar

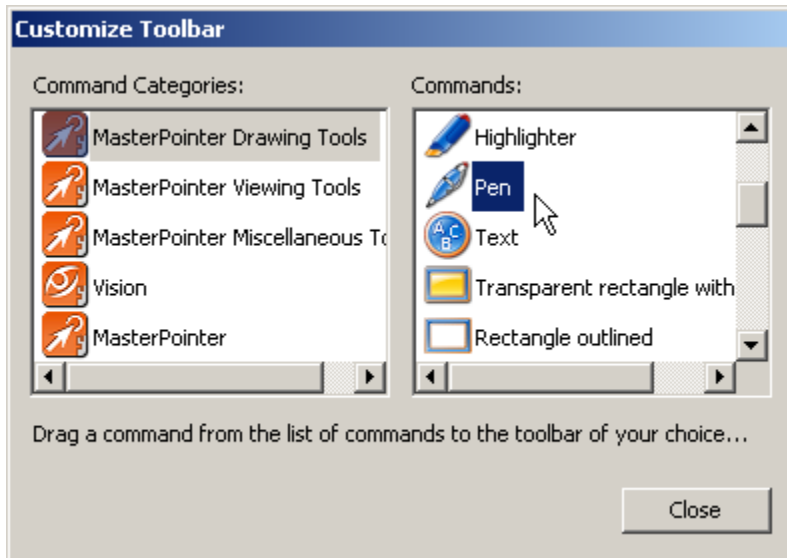
First, make certain that you can see your Vision Toolbar. If the Toolbar does not appear on your desktop, you may enable it by right-clicking on the Vision icon in your system tray and selecting "Use Shortcut-bar" from the Options section of the menu:



Once the Toolbar appears, right-click on the Toolbar to display the pop-up menu and choose **Customize**:



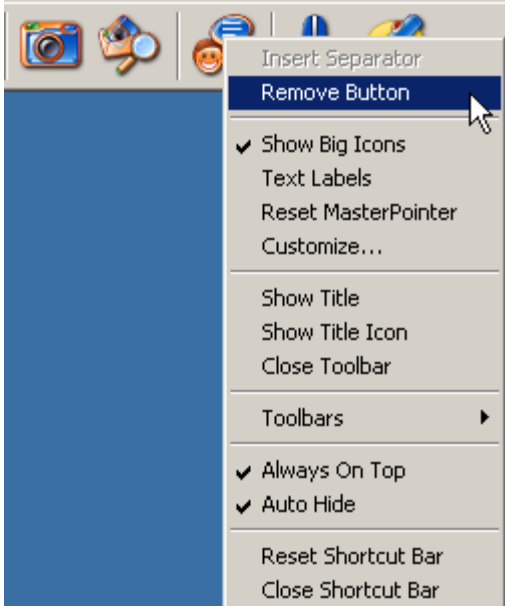
Choose a tool category on the left-hand side of the window. The individual tools will appear in the right side. Scroll down to choose a specific tool:



When you find an individual tool that you would like, simply drag it up and place it on your Vision Toolbar:



If you have tool buttons on the Vision Toolbar that you don't use or would like to remove, just right-click on the specific unwanted tool button in your Toolbar and choose **Remove**:



You can have as many or as few tool buttons as you like. It's your computer – make it your Toolbar!
