## **App-Control Allows Teachers to Remotely Launch Applications, Share Documents on All Classroom Computers**

### ***Enhanced Classroom Management Software Keeps Students Learning Together***

With App-Control, teachers can now use Vision6 to keep the whole class learning together by remotely launching applications, sharing documents and managing access to applications on all student computers. Launched in 1996, Vision is currently used in more than 50,000 classrooms worldwide. Vision6 was released in North America in February 2006.

“At GenevaLogic, our focus is on developing classroom management software that allows teachers to use technology in ways that improve student learning,” said Kirk Greiner, president, GenevaLogic. “The newest addition to the Vision family – App-Control – provides capabilities that help teachers ensure that students are using technology to complete assignments – without distractions.”

Using App-Control with Vision6, teachers can start applications running on student computers with the click of a button. The plug-in also allows them to start the entire class on the same assignment at once by sharing and opening a document simultaneously on student computers in either standard or kiosk mode. Kiosk mode limits students to working within one or more applications selected by the teacher, keeping them focused on the current assignment.

Phillip M. Worley, instructional technology teacher at Milliken Elementary School in Colorado, has tested App-Control with his students. “App-Control makes Vision an even stronger tool for managing computer use in my lab,” he said. “Sometimes, with several groups of

students, I may need each group to be using a different application with or without having access to others. App-Control truly lives up to its name.”

William Dunn, an industrial technology teacher at Morton High School in Morton, Ill., said that one of the greatest challenges to teaching with technology is keeping students on task. “App-Control removes the challenge, focusing the student on only the task,” he said.

App-Control works in any Windows environment where Vision6 is installed. It is available initially in English, with German, French and Italian versions available at the end of April.
